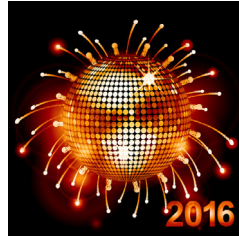

**4TH SEMI-ANNUAL OFF ROAD POKER RUN**

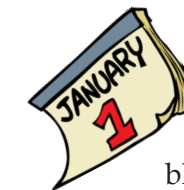
