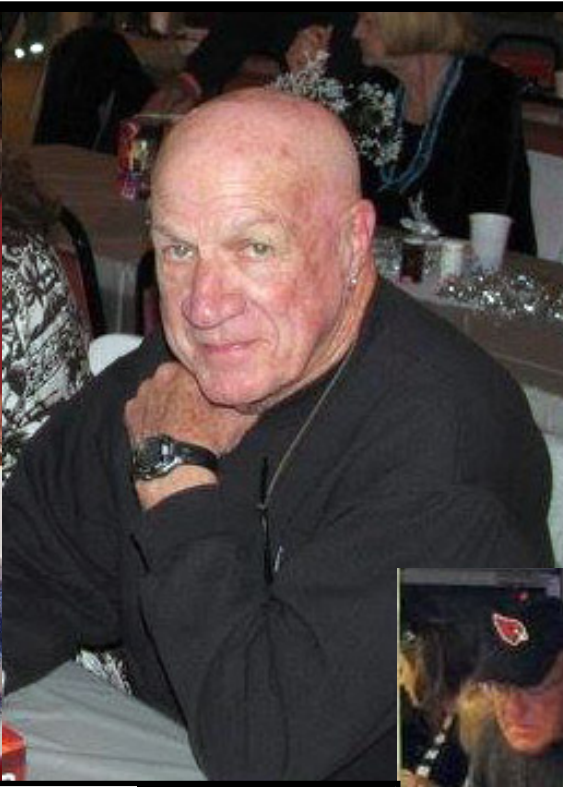


**30th ANNUAL BASH**
