



OBSC Meeting Minutes

Sunday, May 11, 2025

Call to order: President Harry Luker called the meeting to order at 11:08 a. m. Pres. Harry asked if all of the “mothas” picked up a raffle ticket for a special raffle. He also asked that everyone sign the attendance sheet.

Scribe’s report: The minutes were read and accepted.

Treasurer’s report. Beginning balance: \$ 6,748.35 (USD) \$3,482.00 (MXN). Ending balance: \$ 8,185.19 (USD) and \$ 3,500 (MXN).
